

OBJECT LESSON OR KIDS SERMON

ITEMS NEEDED:

A pitcher of water

An empty glass

Pick one kid to come up on stage. Give them the glass of water. Tell the child to say, "stop" to let you know to stop pouring water.

When they say, "stop," stop. Ask them why they said stop. Ask why they didn't want you to pour any more water into the glass. Then let them sit down.

If we kept pouring water into this glass, the water would overflow. The glass would be past its capacity to hold water, wouldn't it?

Today we're talking about streaming music and streaming praise. Water streams do not usually stop, and they don't usually respond if we just tell them to stop. They keep on flowing, on and on. God wants us to keep streaming praise for him because we need it. Unlike this glass of water, there isn't a certain amount of Jesus we need. We, unlike this glass, are leaky, and we need a steady stream of Jesus to keep us full.

Never get tired of praising Jesus. He deserves all the praise we can give, and he loves to hear us sing his name!
