ITEMS NEEDED:

2 Lounge chairs
Sun reflector

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN: 2M

CHARACTERS:

Rob and Tom - Guys relaxing by a pool

The lounge chairs are side by side on stage. Rob enters with a sun reflector. He sits, then opens the reflector and holds it under his chin to get some sun. Tom enters with a Bible.

ROB: Morning, Tom.

TOM: Good morning, Rob.

Tom sits. He opens his Bible and holds it under his chin like a sun reflector. Rob looks over.

ROB: Hey, Tom, what are you doing?

TOM: I'm getting some son.

ROB: You're not doing a very good job.

TOM: I'm not?

SKIT

ROB: That book is never going to help you get a good tan. Here, you need a reflector like this.

TOM: No, my friend, you need a book like this.

ROB: I do?

TOM: I'm not interested in a sun tan. I'm interested in the son of God.

ROB: You mean Jesus?

TOM: That's the guy.

ROB: You picked a funny place to read about Jesus.

TOM: Just because I'm on the beach doesn't mean I can't learn about Jesus. I can learn about Jesus anywhere I go.

ROB: Really?

TOM: Sure!

ROB: Why would you want to do that? Save Jesus for church.

TOM: I can't, bro. Jesus left everything for me. He came from Heaven to die for my sins and let me have a friendship with him. Jesus wants to be with me every day, and I want to be with him.

ROB: Jesus must be quite a guy.

TOM: He's the best, man.

ROB: I don't suppose I could borrow that son reflector of yours, huh?

TOM: Sure, be happy to lend it to you.

Tom hands Rob the Bible. He sits back and closes his eyes.
