*Marcia is on stage with a microphone.*

MARCIA: This is Marcia Baker down at the beach! If you're headed to the beach this summer, you're probably wondering what to bring. I'm here to interview some of the beach regulars to see what it is they never hit the beach without.

*Katy enters carrying a towel.*

MARCIA: Here comes one now. Excuse me, can we talk to you for a second?

KATY: Sure!

MARCIA: What's your name?

KATY: I'm Katy.

MARCIA: Katy, how often do you come to the beach?

KATY: Every day of the summer!

MARCIA: Your towel?

*Katy exits. Skip enters with a towel.*

MARCIA: Yes, you are.

TOBY: Oh, that's wicked!

MARCIA: I'm asking all the beach goers what they think is the most important thing to take to the beach.

TOBY: That's easy. It's my towel.

MARCIA: Really? A towel?

TOBY: Totally. It keeps me dry, and keeps me from getting burned by the sand, and it protects me from crabs.

MARCIA: From crabs? How does a towel do that?

TOBY: Like this.

*Toby rolls his towel up like a whip and whips some imaginary crabs.*

TOBY: Back, crabs, back! Don't pinch me! Get out of here! Stop looking at me, crabs!

MARCIA: Crude, but effective. Thank you, dude.

TOBY: No, prob!

*Toby exits. Skip enters with a towel and a Bible.*
