OBJECT LESSON OR KIDS SERMON

ITEMS NEEDED:

Weather radio

Turn on the weather radio. Ask the kids if they can tell what channel or broadcast they are listening to. See who in the room has a radio like this one at home.

When the weather gets bad, we can use a radio like this to help us stay informed. We can also use a regular radio or a TV. Local radio and TV all have meteorologists on staff to keep us up to date on what's going on outside and what to expect.

Sometimes those meteorologists can get carried away. They get a little too excited, and they say things that could frighten people. It's important that we don't panic and don't get carried away when there's a storm outside. Remember to stay calm, listen to mom and dad, and listen to the radio.

When the storms of life hit us, we have Jesus to help us stay calm. Jesus is there when we are hurt or sick. He's there when we experience loss. Whatever storm you are in, Jesus is with you, just as he was with his disciples. Ask Jesus to calm the storm and calm your heart. He will not leave you, and he will not let you go through that storm alone.
