OBJECT LESSON OR KIDS SERMON

ITEMS NEEDED:

Putter
Golf ball
Cup

Set the cup on its side on the ground. Drop the golf ball about five feet away. Ask for a volunteer who thinks they can putt the ball into the cup. Encourage them to keep their eye on the ball.

It isn't easy sinking that putt. It takes a lot of concentration, doesn't it? You have to keep your eye on the ball and not get distracted. If you do that, you can hit that putt from even further away than this.
